## 1st Regional CHED-UniFAST Interscholastic Quiz Show

Theme: Developing Futures Thinking among UniFAST grantees
May 18, 2022
1:00pm - 3:00pm

#### Guidelines

- I. Participants
  - 1. Only one (1) participant from each Higher Education Institution is allowed.
  - 2. The participant must be a Tertiary Education Subsidy (TES) or Tulong Dunong Program (TDP) grantee.
  - 3. The participant must join the Futures Thinking Hybrid Seminar in the morning session of the same date and venue.
- II. Score and Coverage
  - 1. The quiz show shall cover questions related to Futures Thinking, TES, and TDP guidelines.
  - 2. The questions shall be divided into three (3) levels: Easy, Average, and Difficult. The point system will be as follows:
    - i. Easy round 1 point each
    - ii. Average round 3 points each
    - iii. Difficult round 5 points each

### III. Quiz Show Proper

- 1. Cellular or mobile phones are not allowed during the competition.
- 2. The Quiz Master shall read the question twice while the question itself will be flashed on a screen for the contestants to see.
- 3. The participants shall write their answers after the Quiz Master says the go signal.
- 4. All answers must be written on the white boards provided for each participant. It shall be raised when the Quiz Master presses the buzzer. Failure to do so will signal a warning for the first offense and disqualification for the second.
- 5. Any question or query to the correctness of the answers should be raised before the start of the next question.

### IV. Declaration of Winners

- 1. The team that garnered the highest marks shall be declared as the winner.
- 2. In cases of ties, clincher questions will be raised to break the tie.
- 3. The decision of the judges shall be final and irrevocable.

## V. Awarding and Prizes

The Winners shall be awarded with a Certificate and Cash Prizes during the National Higher Education Day Hybrid Celebration on May 18, 2022.
