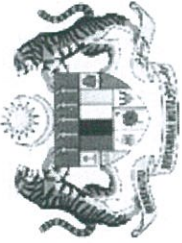

MALAYSIAN TECHNICAL COOPERATION PROGRAMME (MTCP)

The Malaysian Technical Cooperation Programme (MTCP) was officially launched on 7 September 1980 at the Commonwealth Heads of State Meeting in New Delhi, India, to signify Malaysia's commitment to the South-South Cooperation, in particular, the Technical Cooperation among Developing Countries (TCDC).

The MTCP emphasizes on the development of human resources through the provision of training in various areas which are essential for a country's development such as agriculture, economy, finance, public management and administration, science & technology and ICT, health diplomacy, safety and security including cyber security, cultural diplomacy, social development, environment-related to SDG2030, education, industrial and technical training. Annually, Malaysia offered more than 60 technical and capacity-building programs under the MTCP, which have benefited more than 35,500 participants from 144 countries.

OBJECTIVES OF MTCP

- I. To share the development experience with other countries;
- II. To strengthen bilateral relations between Malaysia and other developing countries;
- III. To promote South-South Cooperation (SSC); and
- IV. To promote the technical cooperation among Developing Countries

BACKGROUND OF TRAINING INSTITUTION

The Institute of Teacher Education, International Languages Campus (aka Institut Pendidikan Guru, Kampus Bahasa Antarabangsa or IPGKBA), which is located at Lembah Pantai in Kuala Lumpur, is one of twenty-seven teacher education institutes under the administration of the Institute of Teacher Education, the Ministry of Education. IPGKBA provides training and accreditation for both pre- and in-service teachers pursuing diploma and degree level qualifications in the teaching and learning of English as a Second Language, Islamic Education, and Malay Language.

In addition, IPGKBA in its expanding role provides courses for the teaching and learning of other international languages such as French, Japanese, German and Korean. Recognising the growing demand for these international languages at the local and regional levels, IPGKBA also offers language courses for government and private sector clientele, including non-teaching personnel.

IPGKBA has been conducting MTCP courses since 2001. To date a total of 58 short courses has been conducted for 904 participants from various MTCP participating countries.

COURSE OVERVIEW

This course is designed to provide participants with the opportunities in developing innovative methods in teaching and learning English as a Second Language, as well as to address issues pertaining to assessment in second language teaching. The course will also explore theoretical issues on pedagogy and current practices, including assessment for the different skill areas of language teaching and learning.

This training will be conducted by experts in the field of TESL and Pedagogy in Education from IPGKBA. This programme will be held using an online approach according to the current new normal.

COURSE OBJECTIVES

At the end of this course, participants will be able to:

- Design activities which contain elements of creativity and innovations in teaching and learning contextualised language skills;
- Enhance ELT practitioners' pedagogical skills and assessment knowledge;
- Examine current classroom practices and the impact on learners;
- Provide practical solutions pertaining to English language teaching and learning in contextualised environment;
- Identify and eliminate gaps in assessments through practical approaches; and
- Use a range of authentic assessment strategies and design alternative assessments in context.

COURSE CONTENT

This course covers topics related to the following themes:

- Creativity and Innovation;
- ELT Pedagogy;
- Assessment in ELT;
- Current classroom practices and their impact on learners and teachers; and
- 21 Century Education
- Total hours: 25 hours

- Discussions
- Workshops
- Task-based and hands on activities
- Presentations

CRITERIA OF APPLICANTS

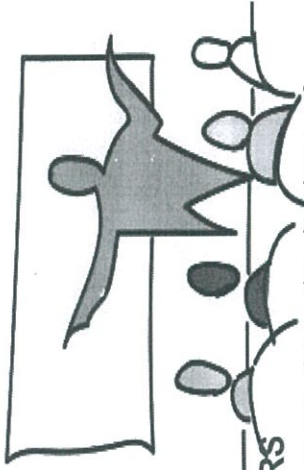
- In-service teacher

- Competent in English language
- Age between 25 to 55 years old
- Basic knowledge of computers and ICT skills
- Has not participated in any course under MTCP

- All application forms must be duly completed and endorsed by the Ministry of Foreign Affairs or National Focal/Aid Coordinator Agency in the respective countries and submitted **ONLY** through the diplomatic channel via the Embassy/High Commission of Malaysia.



MANNERS

- Participants shall conduct themselves at all times in a manner compatible with their responsibilities as MTCP participants and abide by the laws, rules and regulations as may be stipulated by the host government in respect of this training course.
- The course is held entirely on-line, participants must adhere to the schedule by filling up the attendance form each time the course session takes place.
- Participants are required to maintain order and adhere to a proper dress code during the sessions.
- Participants must follow all the given instructions and complete each assignment/ task given for each session.
- Participants need to make sure that they are in a place where internet access is excellent and avoid noisy areas so as to ensure that there is no disturbance throughout the course.
- If the participant fails to complete the total allocated course hours, the certificate will not be issued.
