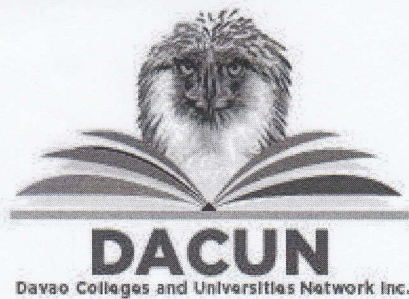
Peace!
