Good day!

The Council of Deans and Program Heads of Criminal Justice Education in Davao Region will be conducting a two-day training/workshop activity on Educational Technologies for Criminology and Forensic Science in collaboration with the Commission on Higher Education Regional Office XI (CHED XI) and the Criminology Department of the University of the Cordilleras (UC), Baguio City on May 19-20, 2022.

This activity has the following objectives:

- 1. Integrate digital technologies in the six (6) Forensic laboratory subjects of the Criminology program through Simulation Applications developed by a project team from UC.
- 2. Provide training in the use of the Simulation Apps to be included in the Forensic laboratory subject activities.
- 3. Introduce and expose faculty members in the Criminology program to new ways of conducting laboratory classes using digital technologies.

Further, the Council has proposed to collect a registration fee of One Thousand Five Hundred (1,500) pesos per participant to generate a budget for the following expenditures:

- 1. Transportation expenses of the Eight (8) Trainers/Facilitators
- 2. Three nights of hotel accommodation
- 3. Meals and snacks for the trainers, facilitators, and participants during the activity
- 4. Other incidental expenses
