As the ongoing response for COVID-19 is deemed to be long-term, the Office of Civil Defense, in accordance with RA 10121 and as the Executive Arm of the National Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Council (NDRRMC), shall prioritize the provision of Capacity Building (CapBuild) and training activities in the field of DRRM and Civil Defense (CD) while adhering to the minimum public health standards for COVID-19 mitigation and adapting to the "new normal" circumstances.
- In support hereof, the Office of Civil Defense XI will be conducting the Basic Incident Command System (BICS) Training Course for RDRRMC XI on April 25-29, 2022 via Zoom Video-Teleconferencing. The BICS training course delivery will be through blended learning (combination of self-paced learning and video-teleconferencing).
- 4. The objective of the BICS Training Course is to be able to provide its trainees with knowledge, skills, and attitude that are essential for the application of basic concepts and principles of ICS in any disaster situation.
