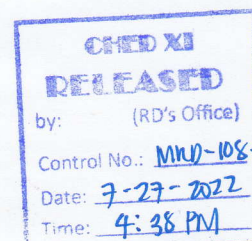

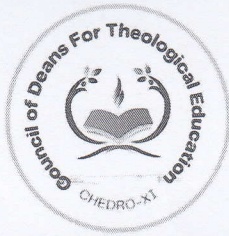

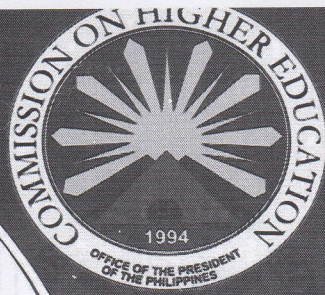
The lectures are also in support to the ASEAN Month celebration with a theme: "ASEAN A.C.T: Addressing Challenges Together, a Theological Reflection".

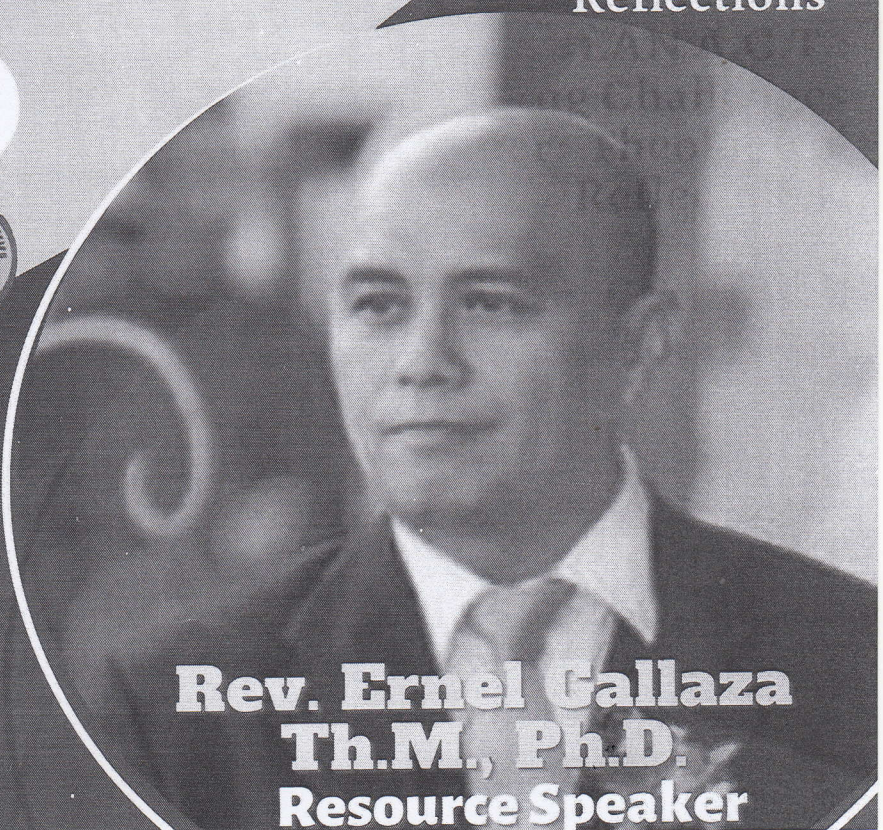
