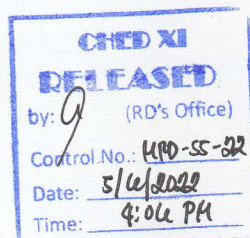

In view of the 28th Founding Anniversary and 2nd National Higher Education Day Celebration, the Commission on Higher Education Regional Office XI (CHEDRO XI) announces the new schedule for the conduct of the **2<sup>nd</sup> Regional Multi-Disciplinary Research Conference of the K to 12 Transition Program's Scholarship for Graduate Studies – Local (SGS-L) Graduates** of this Region on **May 17, 2022**. In this regard, all SGS-L graduated scholars who have not yet presented their thesis and dissertation during the 1<sup>st</sup> Regional Multi-Disciplinary Research Conference are invited to present their thesis and dissertation at the said conference. The research presentation shall include the following aspects: **Introduction, Methodology, Results and Discussions (IMRAD)**, which shall not exceed **eight (8) minutes**. A recorded presentation is encouraged to minimize technical difficulties to be submitted to [kto12regionxi@ched.gov.ph](mailto:kto12regionxi@ched.gov.ph), copy furnished to [eecl@ched.gov.ph](mailto:eecl@ched.gov.ph), not later than **May 13, 2022**. Furthermore, this Office will also come up with a Compendium of Research Abstracts, which will be published once compiled.

This conference aims to: a) compile researches that our SGS-L scholars have done; b) provide a venue for these scholars to present their outputs; c) contribute to the value of knowledge as far as its relevance in the Higher Education Research Agenda; d) promote the culture of research and creative works (RCW) among Higher Education Institution in the region, and; e) recommend possible topics for future researches.
